



Check In Sunday

1:00—3:00 PM

Each Troop will be given a time to check in between 1:00 PM and 3:00 PM. Please call camp if you need to confirm the time or we have not contacted you.

Check In Procedures

- You will be greeted by a staff member who will stay with your Troop Through the check in process.
- Units with trailers will be directed where to park and unhook.
- Units without trailers will load their gear into a trailer provided by the camp.
- Trailers will be hauled to campsites by the ranger staff
- The camp staff will escort the Troop to the designated check in location,
- Each Troop will visit the Health Lodge for a health forms check and to complete a Covid-19 screening form.
- When check in is complete, Troops will be escorted to their campsite to set up camp.
- Camp staff will inform each Troop when they should be at the waterfront for swim checks. Scouts should have access to swimsuits, water shoes, sunscreen, towels and water bottles. These items should be accessible in a day pack, not in the Troop trailer.
- **Swim checks will be held at the waterfront as part of the check in process. Since we are located on a river and conditions are different than a swimming pool or pond, all swim checks must be done by Lewis & Clark aquatic staff.**

Check-out Procedures

- Please schedule a check out time with staff prior to Friday. This is the time to discuss any final merit badge issues, camp advancement reports and settle any outstanding accounts.
- Saturday morning, after your gear is packed, you will inspect your campsite with your Commissioner to make sure the site is ready for the next Troop.
- A 'To Go' breakfast will be provided Saturday morning and can be picked up in the Dining Hall.
- Remember to pick up your Troop's health forms if you have not already done so. Any health forms left at camp will be shredded.
