



Cub Scout Iditarod & Chili Cook-Off

WHO - This event is for Cub Scouts and their families.

WHAT - The Cub Scout Iditarod is a winter event based on the heritage and history of the Alaskan Gold Rush and the trials of the great dog sled racers of the Iditarod. The event is designed for patrols to go from station to station with a traditional Klondike sled to test their skills and leadership ability in the outdoor winter environment.

WHERE -

Shetek Lutheran Ministries Camp
– 14 Keeley Island Drive – Slayton, MN – 56172

Parking will be available before entering Shetek Lutheran Ministries main gate. Follow the signs to the parking area. There will be a parking lot on the left, that is where you leave your car for the duration of the event. Cars may unload gear and drive trailers to the site but must remain in the parking lot during the day.

WHY - The Iditarod will give Cub Scouts the opportunity to work on outdoor survival skills- particularly those required for winter conditions-as well as the opportunity to work as a team at various stations and activities throughout camp. There is also a chili/chowder cook off, for Cub Scouts to work on their cooking skills! Cub Scouts will leave camp with a cool sticker to show off their accomplishments!
