- Responsible for the safe and successful operation of the area

- Develop presentation skills.
- Carry out other duties as assigned by the Camp Director, Program Director.
- During camp a CIT will be assigned to, or be active in, various areas of camp operations. These experiences will provide a broad exposure of all facets of the camp staff. These areas may include assisting Merit Badge Instructors, Area Directors, Dining Hall Staff, Camp Administration, and other duties assigned.
