Position Description

Immediate Supervisor

- Responsible to the Camp Director through the MRHAB Director

Qualifications

- At least 18 years of age
- Has or is willing to take Wilderness First Aid Training
- Has Leave No Trace Master Education (weeklong training) OR Leave No Trace Trainer (2-day training) OR will take
- Experience with Canoeing Treks (trips) with groups
- Current First Aid/CPR Certification
- Thorough knowledge of ALL applicable standards (both BSA and state)
- Is BSA or Red Cross Life guard trained OR if time allows is able to become trained (not required)
- Strong public speaking and communication skills
- Registered with the BSA
- Computer Skills

Responsibilities

- Follows the program designed by the Sioux Council Aquatics Committee
- Insures the sites for camping are properly secured, maintained and treated with proper leave no trace principles
- Cares for and maintains all gear, equipment and canoes for the trek during the camping season
- Works with Head Cook to plan meals for proper ordering
- Sets and sticks to menu for the Trek
- Keeps accurate records for his/her area
- Insure that all aquatic activities conform to the safety standards as established by the Camping Committee
- Promote the Safe Swim Defense Plan for use by the units in camp
- Participate in camp programs as Trek Schedule allows
- Carry out other duties as assigned by the Camp Director or MRHAB Director
