Immediate Supervisor

- Responsible to the Camp Director or Program Director through the Shooting Sports Director

Qualifications

- At least 18 years of age
- Must hold or be willing to be trained as a Range Officer for Shotgun, Rifle, Black powder, Tomahawks or Archery
- Thorough knowledge of ALL applicable standards (both BSA and State)
- Strong public speaking and communication skills
- Registered with the BSA
- Limited Computer Skills

Responsibilities

- Follows the program designed by the Sioux Council
- The shooting Instructor must be in camp when any their range is in use
- Insures their Shooting Sports program areas are properly maintained and treated with in the best possible way
- Cares for and maintains all gear and equipment during the camping season
- Keeps accurate records for their area
- Insure that all activities conform to the safety standards as established by the Camping Committee and NCAP
- Assists Camp with Webelos Camp as the Shooting Sports Director needs
- Carry out other duties as assigned by the Camp Director or Shooting Sports Director
- Directly supervises the safe use of all firearms and ranges in concert with National BSA Camp Standards for shooting sports.
